Actors – Forms/Rehearsal Schedule/Fee Information

Students who plan to participate as actors with the Marching Huskies for the 2010 season should please note the following about forms, band camp, rehearsals and fees:

Forms

All actors should turn in a Uniform Measurement form on July 1st, along with their trip deposit and the other forms indicated in the handbook (Commitment form, Student Health/First Aid Permission Form, Registration and Fees Form).

Band Camp and Rehearsals

Main actor roles (Timmy, Suzie, Weary Willie, Ticket Salesman/Pagliacci/Ringmaster) **must** attend Week Two of Band Camp (Aug 9-13) to learn their parts in the show. These actors are also welcome to attend Week One of Band Camp, also known as Pre-Camp (Aug 3-5), to learn basic marching skills but attendance at either of the Rookie Clinics or Pre-Camp is not required.

Attendance at Wednesday evening rehearsals and Saturday practices (and any other times designated by Mr. Moore) is mandatory.

Other actors - roustabouts, eclectic clowns, circus performers – are welcome to attend Rookie Clinics, Pre-Camp (Aug 3-5) or Week Two of Band Camp (Aug 9-13), but are not required to attend either week of camp. Attendance at Wednesday evening rehearsals and Saturday practices (and any other times designated by Mr. Moore) is mandatory.

Note: Attendance at all home football games and competitions is mandatory.

Fees

All actors **must pay** the \$52 Student Activity Fee.

Actors **do not** need to purchase Drillmasters (marching shoes) or white gloves. The \$5 uniform cleaning fee (for musicians) will be assessed for costume cleaning for actors.

Band Camp meals will be pro-rated based on the number of days attended; main actors will purchase meals during Week Two of Band Camp (Aug 9-13). For all actors, payment for the following meals is required: 3 pre-game meals, 6 competition meals and the Bandquet meal (see handbook and Registration and Fees sheet for details).

Actors **do not** need to pay the \$50 equipment fee.
