

VIOLIN/VIOLA LESSONS

Quarterly Lesson

Private violin/viola lessons at NNHS are scheduled on a quarterly basis. Each quarter consists of 7 (seven) 25 minute lessons over approximately 9 (nine) weeks. I will post the schedule for each quarter on the orchestra door. And will update it as needed. Please feel free to contact me if you have questions or need to reschedule a lesson.

Payment

Payment is due by the third lesson or instruction will be terminated. Payment is \$140 for each quarter. Please make checks payable to “**District #203.**” . If a student begins lessons, but chooses not to continue lessons beyond the payment due date, the student is still responsible for paying for all lessons (attended or missed) up to and including the day of termination. Lessons are \$20 per 25 minutes (\$140/7). Prompt payment upon termination of lessons is appreciated.

Absences

It is the students’ responsibility to inform me of planned absences **24 hours in advance of the lesson.** This policy is for all students including those that are excused absent, sick, on a field trip or at a special assembly. I will make every effort to schedule lessons so that cancellations from my end are not necessary. However, if I am unable to teach a lesson I will give 24 hours notice and schedule a make up time that is convenient for the student.

Jackie began teaching private violin lessons in 1994 at the Betty Haag Suzuki Academy as a cadet violin teacher. She then continued as an assistant violin teacher at The Gail Lilja School for Young Musicians under the primary instruction of Gail Lilja. In 1998, Jackie began teaching lessons through the Community School of the Arts at Northern Illinois University and built up a private studio of violin and viola students from the DeKalb/Sycamore area. From 2003 to 2007 Jackie was a member of the faculty at the Hall School of Music in Wheaton, IL and in early 2004 she acquired a full studio of violin students through the Indian Prairie School District #204 in Naperville/Aurora, IL. After ten years with Northern Illinois University's Community School program, Jackie made the tough decision to leave in May 2008 so she can teach full time locally in the Naperville/Aurora area. She currently has around 55 students in District 204 alone and will be accepting more students at Naperville North High School in District 203 starting this 2008/2009 school year.

In 2002, Jackie graduated from Northern Illinois University with a Bachelor of Music degree in violin performance where she studied under Mathias Tacke of the Vermeer String Quartet. Aside from teaching, she enjoys freelancing around the Chicagoland area where she gets asked to play everything from weddings to composition premieres. Jackie is currently the principal second violinist of the Harper Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Brian Groner, as well as an active member of the Chicago Symphonic Pops Orchestra under the direction of Frank Winkler.
